
ORDINANCE NO. 052-2014

AMENDING SECTION 10 OF SP ORDINANCE NO. 3-94 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROMOTING VOLUNTARY BLOOD DONATION AND MAKING IT MANDATORY THE POSTING OF QUALIFIED VOLUNTARY BLOOD DONORS IN ALL HOSPITALS, RURAL HEALTH UNITS, BARANGAY HEALTH CENTERS AND MEDICAL CLINICS OF INDUSTRIAL ESTABLISHMENTS AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFORE"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Honorable Governor Manuel C. Ortega, in his urgent letter dated April 14, 2014, is respectfully requesting the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan to amend Section 10 of SP Ordinance No. 3-94 to facilitate the immediate implementation of



health sector reforms and to ensure the provision of adequate, safe and affordable supply of blood to patients in need since the Congressmen's Priority Development Assistance Fund (PDAF) for La Union Medical Center is no longer available.

The amendment of the amount from P50,000.00 to P1,000,000.00 was due and intended for the following:

1. Orientation of Punong Barangays on the blood recruitment program;
2. Orientation of Chiefs of Hospitals of District Hospitals and Private Hospitals on Strengthening the Rational Use of Blood;
3. Review the functionality of the Blood Transfusion Committee;
4. The Php1,000,000.00 request shall be for:
 - a. 80% for blood screening subsidy of indigent patients like children with Leukemia;
 - b. 20% for the purchase and maintenance of reasonable stock of consumable items like linens, cot beds, chairs and low stools, while sera, blood bags, test tubes, slides are the counterpart of blood facilities namely, La Union Medical Center, Philippine Red Cross, Ilocos Training and Regional Medical center.

Considering that one of the priority programs of the Provincial Government of La Union is on the promotion of health and safety, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan deems it imperative to amend said ordinance, as requested by the Honorable Governor.

In view of the foregoing premises, the immediate approval of this proposed ordinance is earnestly requested.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session duly assembled, that:

Section 1. Title: The title of the ordinance is hereby read as follows:



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10 OF SP ORDINANCE NO. 3-94 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROMOTING VOLUNTARY BLOOD DONATION AND MAKING IT MANDATORY THE POSTING OF QUALIFIED VOLUNTARY BLOOD DONORS IN ALL HOSPITALS, RURAL HEALTH UNITS, BARANGAY HEALTH CENTERS AND MEDICAL CLINICS OF INDUSTRIAL ESTABLISHMENTS AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFORE.

Section 2. Section 10. Appropriation of SP Ordinance No. 3-94 is hereby amended, the amount of P50,000.00 is hereby deleted and amended to P1,000,000.00 and will now read as follows:

Section 10. Appropriation: The amount of P1,000,000.00 is hereby appropriated for the implementation of this Ordinance, and shall be charged against the "Non Office" appropriations of the province, provided that such amount shall be increased as the need arises.

Section 3. Separability Clause. If any part of this ordinance is declared as unconstitutional or unlawful, such declaration shall not affect the other parts or sections hereof that are not declared unlawful or unconstitutional.

Section 4. Repealing Clause. All previous ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance shall be deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 5. Effectivity – This ordinance shall take effect after posting and publication as provided by law.




