**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 PARAGRAPHS (A), (F) AND (K) AND SECTION 11
OF SP ORDINANCE NO. 001-2007 TITLED: AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE TEN
OUTSTANDING (PUBLIC) SCHOOL TEACHERS OF LA UNION**

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of La Union in session duly assembled:

Section 1. Title: This Ordinance shall be known as an "ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 paragraphs (a), (f) and (k) and SECTION 11 OF SP ORDINANCE NO. 001-2007 TITLED: AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE TEN OUTSTANDING (PUBLIC) SCHOOL TEACHERS OF LA UNION."

Section 2. Section 4 paragraphs (a), (f) and (k) and Section 11 of Ordinance No. 001-2007 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. CRITERIA OF THE AWARD.

a. Demonstrated competence in the use of effective approaches to improve instruction. - 20 pts.

6. intervention activities such as: - 4 pts
- **Remediation** - make-up activities given to slow or fast learners such as module, Strategic Intervention materials and tutoring
 - **Independent/Cooperative Learning** – the K to 12 curriculum is designed to cater to learners according to their abilities and needs. Learners that get along well with their lessons are encouraged to utilize their time for ICL productively. A learner that cannot cope well with the lessons is attended by his/her teacher in a particular subject where he/she finds difficulty.
 - **Enrichment** – The teacher gives another activity or list of activities where learners could choose to do or perform to enhance further their learning.

f. Must have contributed to the improvement of the quality of life in the community. - 5 pts.

1. Sanitation and Beautification
2. Feeding Program
3. Waste Management
4. Food Production/Gulayan sa Paaralan

6. Project SITE (School Initiative Towards Excellence)
 - A program where schools were asked to undertake their own unique program during the school year aside from the usual academic and non-academic activities that are being undertaken. Schools may choose to have year-long activity on academic or non-academic program.

1. International/ASEAN Level - 5 pts
2. National Level - 2 pts. but not to exceed 3
3. Regional Level - 1 pt. but not to exceed 1
4. Division Level - 0.5 pt.

6. School Level - 0.2


Section 3. Section 11 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11. APPROPRIATION. The amount of P70,000.00 shall be annually appropriated from the Human Resource Development Program or from any funds available in the Provincial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for the implementation of this ordinance.

The following are the breakdown of expenses for the year's 2012-2013 LA UNION SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING TEACHERS OF LA UNION:

Cash Prizes	: P 30,000.00
Plaque	: P 30,000.00
Documentation / Program	: P 10,000.00


Section 4. Separability Clause. If any part or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provisions hereof not affected shall remain in force and effect.




Section 5. Repealing Clause. The provisions of any ordinance, executive order or other issuances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


Section 6. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect according to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.
