The cottages, whose materials except for the nails and cement were all sourced from the farm. The designs of the cottages were made to stand all-weather even the strongest winds from typhoons and allow natural light penetration and air circulation, thus it requires minimum use of electricity. "You don't plant a tree, you plant a forest...," Mr. Tamayo stressed as he passionately narrated to the PGLU officials his struggles with the local farmers in developing the 8.5 hectare property which he acquired in 2007.

The nutritional break for lunch was the highlight of the visit. The plate was teeming with healthy and freshly harvested all plant-based menu including
