Executive Order No. 14 Series of 2020

AN ORDER PRESCRIBING THE GUIDELINES IN THE OPERATION OF SARI-SARI STORES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CABA, LA UNION

WHEREAS, the provincial government of La Union issued Advisory No. 4 providing the guidelines in the operation of sari-sari stores in the province;

WHEREAS, the municipal government must enforce the said guidelines to regulate the operation of sari-sari stores in the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, I, RONNIE P. MANGASER, Acting Mayor of the Municipality of Caba, La Union by the power vested upon me by law, do hereby order:

- **Section 1. MANDATORY PREVENTIVE MEASURES.** The sari-sari stores operating in the municipality must implement the mandatory preventive measures against the outbreak of COVID-19 disease such as, but not limited to, the provision of sanititation station/sanitizers and stringent observance of social distancing
- **Section 2. QUARANTINE PASS SLIP.** Only those given an enhanced Quarantine Pass Slip shall be allowed to buy from sari-sari stores within their barangays. As such, the store owner must refuse sale to an individual who could not present his/her Quarantine Pass Slip.
- **Section 3. GOODS TO BE SOLD.** Only items that are considered basic commodities such as rice, canned goods, noodles, water and related household needs shall be sold to the holder of a Quarantine Pass Slip. Alcoholic drinks and cigarettes shall not be sold at any time. Snacks shall not be consumed on site.
- **Section 4. TIME OF OPERATION.** Sari-sari stores shall be opened not earlier than 7 o'clock in the morning and be closed not later than 5 P.M.
- **Section 5. ROLE OF BARANGAY OFFICIALS.** The barangay officials must ensure strict compliance of sari-sari store owners to these guidelines.

Section 6. PENALTIES.

- **a. Article 151 of the Revised Penal Code** for any individual who refuse/resist arrest by the PNP or barangay official for non-cooperation with the directives issued by the national and local government.
- **b. Article 148 of the Revised Penal Code** if such individual/sari-sari store owners committed acts of violence against a person in authority
- **c. Administrative case** against barangay officials who fail to perform their duties in the implementation of precautionary measures.

EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This E.O. shall be effective immediately.
