ADVISORY NO. 36

MONITORING OF THE COMPLIANCE TO THE MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS IN THE WORKPLACES

Due to the influx of CoViD-19 cases in the country, along with the newly detected variants, continued implementation of proactive measures is necessary to ensure the utmost protection of the health of the Filipino people, hence standard health protocols be observed at all times.

The IATF issued Resolution No. 108, Series of 2021 on April 3, 2021 to strengthen the enforcement and implementation of the minimum public health standards, and amended the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines, which are hereby adopted:

A. Pursuant to IATF Resolution No. 108, S. 2021, the following joint recommendations of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) and the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), are adopted:

1. Intensifying the enforcement and monitoring of compliance to the minimum public health standards in the workplaces;
2. Rolling out the Safety Seal Certification Program, as provided for under IATF Resolution No. 87 Series of 2020, issued on December 3, 2020, and its adoption in private companies, hotels, and business establishments, and public transportation units; and
3. Encouraging citizenry reporting of non-compliant establishments through available government channels.


B. Pursuant to the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines (with Amendments as of April 3, 2021), the following establishments, persons, or activities shall not be permitted to operate, work or be undertaken while the Province is under MGCQ:



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1. Entertainment venues such as karaoke bars, bars, clubs, concert halls, and theaters;
2. Fairs/Peryas, kid amusement industries such as playgrounds, playroom and kiddie rides; and
3. Cockfighting and operation of cockpits except for the sole purpose of conducting e-sabong licensed and regulated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation.

The foregoing is likewise without prejudice to the authority of DTI in issuing a list of industries which shall remain prohibited under MGCQ areas.
