RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE APPROVAL AND ADOPTION OF NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT (ARTISTIC WORK) AS AN ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT FOR THE ENGAGEMENT OF AN ARTIST FOR THE POST-EVENT ACTIVITY OF THE LUFA 2024 FOR USE OF THE OFFICE OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, presented before this Body is the need to commission an artist for the Post-event Activity of the LUFA 2024 for the use of the Office of the Provincial Governor in the amount of Two Million Three Hundred Ninety Eight Thousand Pesos Only (P2,398,000.00);

WHEREAS, the PGLU deems that the engagement to a local artist is vital in creating awareness among the people for them to be able to appreciate local filipino music better and stir upon them patriotism and support to developmental initiatives of the government;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 48 of Rule XVI of the Updated 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) of RA 9184, the Procuring Entity may resort to *Alternative Methods of Procurement*, subject to prior approval of the Head of the Procuring Entity and whenever justified by the conditions provided in the aforementioned law;

WHEREAS, Section 53.6 of the same IRR provides Artistic Work under Negotiated Procurement as one of the alternative methods of procurement "*Where Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting Services can be contracted to a particular supplier, contractor or consultant and as determined by the HoPE*", provided, that the terms and conditions for the use of the alternative methods of procurement found in Section 54 shall be followed, if applicable;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), in consideration of the recommendation of the Office of the Provincial Governor and in order to promote economy and efficiency, recommended Artistic Work under Negotiated Procurement as an alternative method of procurement for engagement of an artist for the Post-event Activity of the LUFA 2024 amounting Two Million Three Hundred Ninety Eight Thousand Pesos Only (P2,398,000.00);
