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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Provincial Project Monitoring Committee (PPMC) conducted the 3rd quarter actual field monitoring on October 11 and November 6, 2024. The participants during the activity were as follows: Local Finance Committee (LFC) representatives from the Office of the Provincial Budget Officer (PBO), Office of the Provincial Accountant (OPAcctng) and Office of the Provincial Treasurer (PTO); Office of the Provincial Planning and Development Coordinator (OPPDC); and representatives from the implementing offices, which include the following: Office of the Provincial Agriculturist (OPAg), Office of the Provincial Veterinarian (OPVet), PG Environment and Natural Resources Office (PG-ENRO), and Provincial Engineer Office (PEO).

A total of 16 infrastructure projects of various types were visited and assessed accordingly in order to evaluate the current status of projects as basis for future project improvement. Among the total projects monitored, ten projects were funded under RA 7171, three projects were funded under Development Fund (DF), two projects were funded under RA 8240 and one project were funded under Special Education Fund (SEF).

This report contains the findings observed and their respective recommendations for each project visited for appropriate action of concerned offices.

During this quarter, the PPMC also assessed the conduct of the field monitoring and came up with opportunities for improvement for consideration in the future conduct of the activity such as (1) Implementing Office should provide the original and revised plan in accordance with the change/variation order, and (2) the contractors must be informed of the project defects within the one-year defect liability period in order for them to perform the necessary repairs or address the concerns and shall be cascaded to and monitored by the PEO to be reported to the PPMC on a monthly basis.

IMPROVEMENT OF IPET-POBLACION-TUROD FARM TO MARKET ROAD (Phase III), Sudipen

RA 7171 | Php 3,888,300.00

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project covers the improvement of a 68.00 meter x 5.00 meter x 0.23 meter thick Portland Cement Concrete Pavement (PCCP). The Phase 1 of the project was completed in 2022 while the Phase II was completed in 2023. The project started on October 6, 2023 and was completed on January 16, 2024.


ESTABLISHMENT OF SOLAR POWERED IRRIGATION SYSTEM (SANTOL, LUNA, ROSARIO), Santol Site

ROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project aims to improve the quality of life of marginal farmers through the Construction of Solar - powered Irrigation System, a modernized technology that utilizes renewable energy in its operation making the sector less dependent on fossil-based technology. The project covers the construction of 10.00 mtr by 6.00 mtr perimeter fence, 3.30 mtr by 2.20 mtr steel structure for vertical gravity tank (6.00 mtr high), 12 units of solar panels, water pumping and distribution system and electricals for each of the 3 sites located in Santol, Luna and Rosario. The project started on May 21, 2024 and is currently ongoing with 60 percent accomplishment as of August 30, 2024 and is expected to be completed on October 18, 2024.

The project started on April 15, 2024 and was completed on July 25, 2024 which is ahead from its revised completion date of August 13, 2024.

CONCLUSION

A total of 16 infrastructure projects were visited during the 3rd quarter 2024 actual field monitoring activity on October 11 and November 6, 2024. All enlisted projects were monitored accordingly and the monitoring team managed to accurately assess and evaluate the projects visited. Among the common findings observed were as follows:

- Workmanship of most projects visited were commendable;
- Few of the projects visited were already being used and received positive feedback from beneficiaries/end-users;
- For the completed projects, the end users were informed of their role to maintain the structure's cleanliness, usability and structural integrity;
- For the ongoing projects to be completed within their target duration of implementation; and
- Some projects have minor structural damages that need to be repaired by the contractor;

With the above enumerated findings, the resident Engineers of the PGLU have been initially informed during actual field monitoring for appropriate action. The PPMC will ensure that actions to be taken shall be done accordingly by the contractor in coordination with the implementing office/s. A monitoring report of the actions taken by the concerned offices shall be prepared during the succeeding quarter (Q4 2024).

MOVING FORWARD

To enhance future project implementation and as per agreement during the post-assessment of the conduct of the 3rd Quarter 2024 Actual Field Monitoring activity, the Monitoring Team has reiterated the following general recommendations:

- Sustain the quality of works as per scope of works, specifications and standards;
- COA Billboard must be updated monthly to ensure transparency of the status or progress of the on-going project/s;
- Strict compliance in the use of PPE must be imposed and monitored;
- Implementing office should provide a copy of the Change/Variation Order with computation and the original and revised plan for comparison; and
- The contractors must be informed of the project defects within the one-year defect liability period in order for them to perform repairs / address the concerns. This shall be cascaded through the PEO and shall be monitored by the PPMC;

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
