



**RESOLUTION NO. 091-AG s. 2024**

**BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING YNAD'S PLACE HOTEL AND RESORT AS THE LOWEST CALCULATED RESPONSIVE QUOTATION (LCRQ) AND RECOMMENDING AWARD OF CONTRACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Government of La Union (PGLU) advertised on September 6, 2024 the Request for Quotation for the **Lease of Venue with Provision of Food and Room Accommodation** with the **Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC)** of **Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (P400,000.00)** in the BAC Bulletin Board at the Provincial Capitol continuously for 5 days;

**WHEREAS**, in response to the said advertisement, three (3) suppliers submitted their quotations as follows:

- To recommend for the approval of award to the Provincial Governor of the Province of La Union based on the foregoing findings.
