

Framework Agreement

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Agreement made and entered into by and between <u>Provincial Government of La</u> <u>Union (PGLU)</u> of the Philippines with office address at Aguila Road, Brgy. II, City of San Fernando La Union, represented by <u>HON. RAPHAELLE VERONICA ORTEGA-DAVID</u>, Provincial Governor and hereinafter referred to as the "PROCURING ENTITY"

and

PRE-AN'S ENTERPRISES, duly registered entity existing under the laws of the Philippines, with postal address at San Fernando, Pampanga, represented by **NOEL C. PEREZ**, Sales Representative, hereinafter referred to as the "SUPPLIER",

WITNESSETH, that:

WHEREAS, the Supply and Delivery of X Ray, Ultrasound and Dental Supplies- Framework Agreement (Early Procurement Activity) utilized by the different departments and units under the Provincial Government of La Union (PGLU) regularly requires supply and delivery thereby calling for the procurement of goods and services under the applicable provisions of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act";

WHEREAS, such procurement necessitates entering into ordering agreements for necessary and desirable goods which are (1) by its nature, use, and characteristic, the quantity and/or exact time of need cannot be accurately pre-determined, as well as (2) inadvisable for the procuring entity to carry the same in stock or commit to purchase a certain quantity within a given period;

WHEREAS, under item 2.2 of Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) Resolution 12-2017 dated April 10, 2017, a Framework Agreement, as a contractual arrangement, may be used for expendable or non-expendable goods that are repeatedly required by the procuring entity in the regular course of business; and, for services, such as, hotel accommodation, air travel, including simple and non-complex services, such as, but not limited to, janitorial, security, catering, maintenance and repair services.

WHEREAS, the Procuring Entity decided to use a Framework Agreement on its procurement project for the Supply and Delivery of X Ray, Ultrasound and Dental Supplies- Framework Agreement (Early Procurement Activity) of the Provincial Government of La Union; and

WHEREAS, the use of the Framework Agreement is advantageous to the PGLU.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

Article I

GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

- This Framework Agreement is an option contract. THE PROCURING ENTITY is given the option to either purchase the identified items in the Framework Agreement or not to purchase at all. The discretion to exercise the option falls solely with THE PROCURING ENTITY. THE SUPPLIER may not require or demand for the latter to purchase the items in the Framework Agreement List.
- 2. In this Framework Agreement, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract which is attached thereto and made and integral part thereof.
- 3. The following documents shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this Agreement:

- (a) the Supplier's Bid, including the Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents/statements submitted (e.g. bidder's response to clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;
- (b) the Framework Agreement List and the Technical Specifications;
- (c) the General Conditions of Contract;
- (d) the Special Conditions of Contract;
- (e) the Performance Security or Performance Securing Declaration;
- (f) the Procuring Entity's Notice to Execute Framework Agreement;
- (g) Mini Competition, when necessary; and

(h) Call-Offs.

Article II

DURATION

The term of this Agreement shall be from March 27, 2025 to December 31, 2025 unless sooner revoked by both parties.

Article III

CONSIDERATION

For the consideration of one peso (Php 1.00), THE PROCURING ENTITY have the option to purchase any or all of the items in the Framework Agreement List through the issuance of Call-off and THE SUPPLIER commits to deliver the goods and perform the services subject to the conditions of the Call-off.

Article IV

PERFECTION OF PROCUREMENT CONTRACT

The Framework Agreement being an option contract, a procurement contract is perfected only when THE PROCURING ENTITY exercises the option to procure any item from the Framework Agreement List through the issuance of a Call-off.

Article V

OBLIGATION TO ANSWER A CALL-OFF

Once THE PROCURING ENTITY issues a Call-off, THE SUPPLIER is bound to deliver the goods or perform the services identified at the time and date specified in the Call-off.

Failure on the part of THE SUPPLIER to deliver goods or perform the services shall warrant forfeiture of performance security or performance securing declaration and imposition of liquidated damages as provided for in the Guidelines on use of Framework Agreement by all Procuring Entities without prejudice to all other applicable sanctions.

Article VI

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The terms and conditions of this Framework Agreement shall be governed by Guidelines on the use of Framework Agreement by all Procuring Entity and all relevant issuance of the GPPB.
